



THE SKYE TERRIER CLUB SCOTTISH BRANCH CONSTITUTION

1. Only full paid up members of the Skye Terrier Club who are resident in Scotland may be full members of the Branch with voting rights. Associate members, who again must be fully paid up members of the Skye Terrier Club, may be members of the Branch but without voting rights. They do not have to reside in Scotland.
2. A Scottish Branch subscription, decided at the annual general meeting of the Branch, to be paid annually to the Hon. Treasurer of the Skye Terrier Club along with the club subscription. The Branch subscriptions to be forwarded to the Branch Treasurer in a lump sum.
3. A Branch report to include a financial statement to be read out at the club's Annual General Meeting of the club.
4. Two members of the Scottish Branch committee may attend meetings of the parent club committee.
5. The parent club committee via its Chair to be informed of all activities that the Branch wish to hold at least one month before hand.
6. All stationary or correspondence from the Branch to be headed Skye Terrier Club (Scottish Branch).
7. The judging lists of the parent club to be referred to and respected at all times.
8. Formation of the Scottish Branch committee to be selected from paid up members of the Skye Terrier Club, bearing in mind that the Branch is for the benefit of all Scottish members. This committee should consist of eight members including a Chair, Secretary, and Treasurer. The officials and committee members to be elected annually at the Annual General Meeting of the Branch. Five to constitute a quorum.
9. The committee of the Skye Terrier Club (Scottish Branch) reserve the right to disband the Branch if membership drops down below fourteen (14) or in the case of disbandment due to lack of support or misdemeanour all monies (and assets) will be donated to the Skye Terrier Club for the benefit of Skye Terriers. E.g. Health Fund or Rescue Fund.
10. The rules of the Skye Terrier Club apply at all times to the Scottish Branch
